The Junior Sponsor will send home a Field Trip Permission Form for the Breakfast.

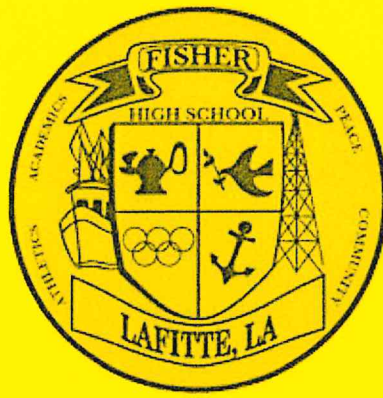
Please sign and return to her as soon as possible.
